




WHAT IS KAZUMA SAFARI CAMP?

Kazuma Safari Camp is an unfenced, seasonal solar powered, self-catering and self-drive tented camp. Open from April to November inclusive. The camp offers accommodation for up to 12 guests and includes comprehensive raised ensuite tents, a well-appointed kitchen, main seating area, and a sunset deck and swimming pool with a braai area. The ensuite tents overlook a permanent pan, whilst the sunset deck overlooks Kazuma depression and a small seep.



LOCATION

Kazuma Safari Camp is situated within the Kazuma Pan National Park, along the eastern edge of the Kazuma Depression. Kazuma Pan National Park is located in North Western Matabeleland, Zimbabwe. Approximately half way between Hwange National Park and Victoria Falls, along the border between Zimbabwe and Botswana, about 30kms North of Panda Matenga Border Post.



ACCESS: SELF DRIVE

- This is a strictly 4x4 park
- 3 hours from Victoria Falls, via Panda Masuie forest reserve
- 2 hours from Nantwich Entrance, Hwange National Park (via Panda Matenga Border Post)
- 1 hour from Panda Matenga Border post

Please note there is no fuel available in Kazuma National Park.



DISCOVER KAZUMA SAFARI CAMP



ACCOMMODATION

- 4 elevated ensuite tents with large front stacking doors opening onto private balconies
- 2 twin/double tents and 2 family tents (double bed + 2 XL single beds)



Each tent offers:

- Expansive sunrise views over Tsessebe pan
- Insulated roofs with well ventilated, insect proof mesh floor to ceiling windows with zip up canvas blinds
- Ensuite hot /cold pressure shower with gas geyser, hand basin and cupboard
- Separate private WC
- Stand up pedestal fans
- Room lighting including bedside reading lights and universal plug points with USB connections
- Mosquito nets



FAMILY TENTS OR TWIN TENTS



MAIN LOUNGE AND DINING AREA

- Comfortable lounge seating area and 2x6- seater dining room tables
- Covered by a bedouin style tent, with a sand free ground sheet
- Stand up fans
- Wifi

KITCHEN

- Fully equipped self-catering kitchen, designed to accommodate 2 separate groups. The kitchen is insulated, well vented, with pull up blinds and secure from rodents, baboons and honey badgers.
- 2 x 250ltr Fridge freezers
- A 4 plate gas stove and a 5-plate gas hob
- Kettles & Toasters
- All utensils, crockery and cookware
- Wash up area with hot water





ELEVATED SUNSET DECK AND SWIMMING POOL

- Viewing deck with sunset views over the Kazuma Depression, and a small seep.
- 1.5m plunge pool with seating
- Outside dining furniture
- Pool lounges and an umbrella

BRAAI AREA AND FIRE PIT

- Wood fired Braai with plough disc and grid
- Wood fired Brazier
- Director Chairs and side tables
- All braai equipment
- Counter top with basin


VIEWING PLATFORM ABOVE WATERTANK



- 8m tall observation deck above watertank
- 360' views of Kazuma Pan National Park
- Open roofed - ideal for celestial, sunrise and sunset viewing
- Deck has tall balustrades
- Accessed by a cat ladder, at your own risk.



INFORMATION



GENERAL INFORMATION


- The camp is serviced daily by 2 general camp hands, from 6am to 6pm
- Bed linen and bathroom towels are provided
- Toilet paper is provided
- LPG gas for kitchen and tents is provided
- Borehole water is available throughout the camp and is safe to drink
- This is a self-catering and self-drive camp
- Complimentary wifi available in the main area
- There is no Zimbabwean cellphone network coverage in camp only Botswana coverage.
- Information Board available in camp
- PLEASE REMOVE ALL YOUR RUBBISH FROM CAMP

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

KSC is situated within a wildlife wilderness area, offering a unique and immersive experience amidst nature. However, this setting also presents potential dangers.

As a guest, it is essential to be aware of you surroundings at all times, and take necessary precautions to ensure your safety. Wildlife, including Lion, Elephant and Buffalo roam freely in this area, and encounters may occur.

Particular caution is advised at night, when visibility is reduced, and wildlife is more active. When walking around the camp after dark (do not let children walk around unattended), please use the designated pathways, carry a torch and head torch at all times and avoid wandering into the surrounding bush.





WHAT TO BRING FOR USE IN CAMP

- Food and drinks, including bottle water if preferred
- Personal toiletries including bath and hand soap
- Swimming towels
- Insect repellent and sunscreen
- Torches - head and flash lights are recommended
- Good binoculars are essential
- Kazuma Safari Camp Map
- Jacket or jersey in winter months
- Firewood – please purchase from Kazuma Parks HQ.
- Adequate fuel
- Limited ice is supplied via ice trays in the deep freeze

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Minimum stay of 2 nights
- Check in at 2pm and check out at 10am
- All rooms and lounge/dining areas are non-smoking
- Please report to National Parks HQ in Kazuma Pan National Park to settle your various Parks Fees
- There are no credit card facilities in camp or at National parks HQ
- Zimbabwe National Parks does not allow fruit inside the park as this can encourage animals to seek it out. Feeding of animals is detrimental to their long-term wellbeing and is not permitted
